


Kopieren Sie die neue *kanjinfo.dat* aus diesem Paket in das Installationsverzeichnis von JWPce. Falls Sie die dort bereits vorhandene, alte *kanjinfo.dat* dabei nicht löschen möchten, benennen Sie sie vorher um, z.B. in *kanjinfo.dat.old*.

Starten Sie JWPce.

Im Menü "*Utilities*", wählen Sie "*Setup Char Info...*"



Wählen Sie unter "*Character Information*" den obersten Eintrag der zweiten Spalte als "**Heisig**" aus.



Klicken Sie dann auf "OK".

Wenn Sie auf der Texteingabefläche nun ein Kanji markieren und die Menü-Schaltfläche "Char Info" anklicken (oder die Tasten Strg+I drücken), erhalten Sie ein Informationsfenster mit der Heisig-Nr. und dem deutschen Schlüsselwort aus "Die Kanji lernen und behalten". Dies ist sehr hilfreich, wenn Sie die Kanji mit diesem Buch erlernen.
